It's now official: The Municipal Hub will be located on Émile-Bouchard Street

Vaudreuil-Dorion, August 29, 2018 – The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion is pleased to announce that it now officially has ownership of Lot 4 559 873, intended as the location of the new municipal hub.

The acquisition of this lot, located on Émile-Bouchard Street, confirms the execution of the municipal pole project. The completion of this important step means that the Municipal Administration can now move onto the next phase of the project, which is that of preparing the architectural design competition.

“The municipal hub is a major project for the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion and, in the end, it is our citizens who will reap the benefits of close proximity to services in this high-density sector. The architectural competition will provide a range of projects to choose from and will help us ensure consistency of aesthetic elements and of all other aspects, at every phase of the project. I would like to mention that citizens will be called upon to provide their input during the architectural competition,” declared Mayor Guy Pilon. “Where the aquatic complex is concerned, the City is currently in the preliminary phase of the project. We will begin to meet with different aquatic associations shortly in order to establish their needs and gather their suggestions. We want to be ready to apply for a grant as soon as the new government programs are unveiled.”

Recall that, during its meeting of August 16, 2018, the municipal council adopted a resolution regarding the expropriation of Lot 4 559 873 so that this location could be used for the new city hall building, a municipal library, an aquatic centre and a public space.

As was recently announced, construction of the new city hall building and library must be completed by early 2022.
