Maison Félix-Leclerc launches its Fall programming this Friday!

Vaudreuil-Dorion, September 11, 2023 – Fridayeveningget-togethers at the Salon Maison Félix-Leclerc will resume this week as Stéphan Daigle welcomes Annouchka Gravel Galouchko, Stéphane Beaulieu, Catherine Michaud, Colin Miquet and Henriette Milard to his popular *Cabaret littéraire*, the first of a series of three to be presented this fall. These events serve as a platform for local authors to introduce their creative works to the public. Several artists and artisans from different disciplines are then scheduled to follow suit until the end of November.

The venue located at 186, chemin de l'Anse offers an intimate atmosphere that appeals both to the public and to the artists who perform there. A variety of musical performances will be presented by artists such as Réjean Turbide, Jean Petitclerc, Madeleine Royer and Jean-François Haché. CSUR la télé will present *La Face cachée de l'île*, a documentary on the collective memory of Terrasse-Vaudreuil directed by André Desrochers, Chantal Bédard and Lucie Asselin. Lucie Bisson will interpret *Mon arbre à moi*, once again demonstrating her talents as a storyteller. To add a little humour, Patrick Richard and Stéphane Lacas will present *Un dernier tour de disque*, a lively number featuring vinyls recorded by artists and humorists from the 1940s and 1980s. Finally, the theatre company Les Philanthropes will close the Friday get-togethers at the Salon with a reading of Michel Tremblay's musical *Les Héros de mon enfance*.
