Five young athletes receive financial support from the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion

Vaudreuil-Dorion, November 14, 2023 – The Municipal Council met last night with five young athletes from Vaudreuil-Dorion, all considered as Hopefuls, Successors or Elites by their federation and competing in various disciplines, to give them a sum of money to help them pursue their athletic journey. In total, the City contributed \$3,000 in 2023 as part of its policy on athlete support.

The purpose of this financial support is to highlight the athletic performance of young athletes in Vaudreuil-Dorion and encourage their participation in major sporting events such as championships, selections or competitions at the provincial, national or international level, or advanced and specialized training camps offered by their federation and required for their development.

This year, the following athletes received funding to finance a portion of their participation in championships:

- Éllie-Maude Roy and Aurélie Bélanger, volleyball
- Éloi Gagnon, baseball
