Spring Break in Vaudreuil-Dorion promises to be a lot of fun!

Vaudreuil-Dorion, January 23, 2024 – For this year's Spring Break - from March 4th to 8th, 2024 - the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion has planned a wide range of activities for its residents. Two options are being offered to parents, consisting of either a Full day camp, with registration beginning at noon on February 7th, or one-time activities, with registration beginning at 9:00 a.m. on February 14th on the City's website at ville.vaudreuil-dorion.qc.ca.

Day Camp

The Spring Break Day Camp is open to Vaudreuil-Dorion residents aged five to twelve, and will take place at the *Centre Sportif du Campus de la Cité-des-Jeunes* (400 avenue Saint-Charles). The camp schedule will be from Monday to Friday - 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., and daycare services will be available from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Over the course of the week, kids will become detective trainees to help the coordination team that has been the victim of a robbery! Their role will require that they interview witnesses, follow up on leads, and question suspects. Will they succeed in identifying the thief and recovering the missing items? The program will also include activities in the gym and outdoors, as well as sports and cooperative games.

One-time activities

From March 4th to 8th, citizens will also have the opportunity to participate in about forty à la carte activities organized by the City, including a variety of workshops, a babysitting course, individual takehome kits, as well as drop-in activities, sports and outdoor play. Collaborators such as *La Ribouldingue*, *L'Atelier Paysan*, *KokoBrik*, *Bricolo Café Céramique*, *Studio de danse 118* and *Éducazoo*, to name just a few, will also be offering kids their expertise during fun artistic, culinary and scientific workshops.

Space is limited, and registration is required for most of the activities. The child's citizen card will be required at the time of registration starting at 9:00 a.m. on February 14th. Some activities are offered free of charge, while others require a registration fee.

Skating and free swim

Citizens who wish to do so will be able to skate free of charge at the municipal arena (9 rue Jeannotte) from Monday to Friday - 10:30 to 11:50 a.m. (glace Vaudreuil) and from 1:15 to 4:50 p.m. (glace Dorion). As for the indoor pool (400 avenue Saint-Charles, pavillon J), an inflatable play structure (Wibit) will be set up in the water on March 5th and 7th during the afternoon. Those interested will also be able to take part in a discovery activity (diving, swimming or fitness) from Monday to Thursday from 9:00 to 10:00 a.m.

Throughout the week of Spring Break, youths are also invited to visit the library (51 rue Jeannotte) to create digital projects at the Lab. Operating hours for this creative space will be from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. from March 4th to 8th and from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on weekends.
