## Vaudreuil-Dorion prepares to host Feux et flocons, complete with DJ and fireworks!

**Vaudreuil-Dorion, January 31, 2024 –** The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion is inviting the population to attend the *Feux et flocons* event on Saturday, February 24th at 7 p.m., at *Parc de la Maison-Valois,* where DJs Adrien Tosti and Tizi are scheduled to perform from the MIXBUS Studio roof - a former school bus converted into a stage. The ever-popular fireworks display will light up the sky over the bay of Vaudreuil starting at around 9 p.m.

"Since its creation, *Feux et flocons* has won the praise of all citizens and has become a not-to-be-missed event. This year, we are pleased to add a youth component to our programming with the *Le Loop* igloo and its Introduction to Djing workshop. Residents will also be able to enjoy the park's winter slide, which will include special animation for the occasion," said Vincent Bastien, Director of Recreation and Culture.

As the show's headliner, Montreal's Tizi is sure to fire up the stage at *Parc de la Maison-Valois* with her groovy and funky electronic arrangements featuring hip-hop, disco, rock and pop influences. Renowned for her unparalleled ability to adapt to any audience, the artist, with her career spanning 12 years, has performed at Quebec's largest venues and iconic festivals such as the Bell Centre, ÎleSoniq, Igloofest, Piknic Électronik, Beachclub and New City Gas.

The first part of the evening will feature DJ Adrien Tosti from 7 p.m. to 8:15 p.m. Other activities planned for the event include a graffiti workshop with *Comité Jeunesse La Presqu'île*, an introduction to Djing workshop with DJ Kleancut, *La Caravane Mozaïk* in techno mode, a slide complete with animation, street entertainers, and a firework display around 9 p.m.

Hungry event-goers will have the opportunity to purchase a bite to eat from the Frit & Gof food truck and alcoholic beverages will be sold at the bars. Please note that alcohol brought in from outside is not permitted on the site. Coffee and hot chocolate will be available for free to warm up chilly hands. Also note that the ice oval at *Parc de la Maison-Valois* will be closed as of February 22nd to allow for set-up operations on the site, and will remain closed until the end of the event.
