The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion grants nearly \$900,000 to its organizations

Vaudreuil-Dorion, March 18, 2024 – On Thursday March 14th, the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion brought together representatives from community, cultural, sports, and leisure organizations operating within its territory to thank them for the essential role they play in the community. The meeting was focused on networking and was also an opportunity to award these organizations grants totaling nearly \$900,000 to support them in their various activities.
